

DRESS ON THE GOLF COURSE

- All clothes not designed for golf activities or styles of clothes not sold in the Golf Shop, are subject to approval by the Head Golf Professional. Please observe the Pro Shops request at the time of play. You may send letters of consideration to the Green Committee.
- Gentlemen must wear shirts with a collar. Traditional mock collars and turtlenecks are considered collars if there is a true collar band and the garment is designed for golf. Half-mocks, tee shirts, tank tops, cut-offs, warm-ups, scrubs, swim wear are not allowed anywhere on the golf course, including the driving range.
- Adults should wear shirts tucked in unless they are designed to be worn outside. Juniors under 18 years old must tuck their shirts in.
- Cargo shorts are allowed but must be neat, and have no frayed hems, holes, or open pockets.
- No clothing may display profanity or offensive images.
- Hats must be clean and not worn backwards or to the side.
- Ladies shorts must be of a conservative length (no more than 8" above the knee).
- Metal spikes may not be worn on the Club property.
